LOCATION

The Faculty of Horticulture is one of the five academic structures that constitute the University of Agricultural Sciences and Veterinary Medicine (UASVM) from Cluj-Napoca, Romania. UASVM Cluj-Napoca is ranked by the Romanian higher education agencies as being the first Romanian public Life Sciences institution for higher education.

Geographically, it is located in Romania, an Eastern European country that shares its borders with Hungary to the Northwest, Serbia to the Southwest, Bulgaria to the South, Ukraine and the Republic of Moldavia to the Northeast and to the East. It is the second largest country in the area, after Poland. Romania is member of the European Union since 1st of January 2007.



LIFE SCIENCES IN CLUJ-NAPOCA

The history of the life sciences higher education began in October 1869, when one of the oldest European Institutions was founded, The Institute of Agronomic Studies, Cluj-Mănăştur. In 1906, the Institute reached the level of Academy, becoming The Academy of Agriculture, Cluj. In 1929, following the reorganization and modernization of the Romanian higher agronomic education, it became The Academy of High Agronomic Studies, Cluj. Since 1948, the institution has been represented by only one faculty, the Faculty of Agriculture. In 1962 the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine was created, followed in 1968 by the Faculty of Animal Sciences. In 1977 was created the Faculty of Horticulture and in 2012, the Faculty of Food Sciences.

In the fall of 2012, the University enrolled over 5,000 Bachelor students, 1,000 Master students and 500 PhD students. The staff of the UASVM Cluj-Napoca, includes academic (255 persons), non-academic (186 researchers and technicians) and 79 administrative staff. The University focuses on excellence in research and education in the broad area of life sciences being integrated into the European Higher Education and Research Areas, for the benefit of the national and the international community.




Our students have the opportunity to make their own research contribution by conducting research projects in the laboratories of these leading scientists in the final bachelor year, the master and the doctoral programs.

The academic year is divided into two semesters (winter and summer semesters), lasting 14 teaching weeks each. They are followed by a three-week examination period. Currently, there are about 2,500 students studying at the Faculty of Horticulture every year, as bachelor, master and doctoral students. The Faculty has adopted the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS) therefore, one master programme and some courses are provided in the English language.

The future specialists in horticulture can create small related businesses or can deliver technical and marketing knowledge in vineyards, orchards, greenhouses or field horticultural production. There are some specially equipped facilities at students' disposal such as: vegetable and flower greenhouse laboratories, didactical orchard and vineyard, extensive assortments of ornamental plants and unique gene-pool collections of fruit plants, grapevine, perennial vegetables, forestry and medicinal plants. Everything is located in the faculty campus.





The landscape architecture graduates can create landscaping designs for parks, gardens or interior management. It involves the systematic investigation of existing social, ecological, and geological conditions and processes in the landscape, and the design of interventions that will produce the desired outcome. In order to prepare them, there are some specially equipped facilities at students' disposal such as: an agro-botanical garden; advanced equipment for measurement and design purposes; and not ultimately professional software.

Forestry is the interdisciplinary profession that creates, manages, uses, and conserves the forests and the associated resources in a sustainable manner to meet desired goals, needs, and values for human benefit. The students have the opportunity to use performed didactic equipment and laboratories. All the practical training is held in the Somesul Cald didactic centre, a 1,000 km2 forest area administrated by our researchers.



The graduates in economic engineering in agriculture can manage an agriculture business and work in the administrative sector of the rural development funds management. They are the future entrepreneurs from the rural area. The two tourism programs prepare future specialists ready to use the natural and anthropic touristic attractions in a sustainable way.

It is a quarterly peer-reviewed journal aimed at disseminating significant research and original papers, critical reviews and short reviews on Life Sciences and Medicine, development of new methodologies that can be of interest to a wide audience of scientists in all areas of Biology sciences. THE FACULTY DEPARTMENTS AND THE ACADEMIC STAFF

The Faculty of Horticulture is divided into four departments. They are the core of the academic and the research activity.
